

# Ingredients:

- 1 bar of castile soap (unscented or scented, depending on preference)
- 1 cup washing soda
- 1 cup borax
- Optional: 15-20 drops of essential oil (such as lavender, tea tree, or eucalyptus) for fragrance

### Instructions:

#### 1. Grate the Soap:

• Using a cheese grater, grate the entire bar of castile soap into fine shreds.

### 2. Mix the Ingredients:

• In a large mixing bowl, combine the grated soap, washing soda, and borax. Stir the mixture well to ensure an even distribution of ingredients.

#### 3. Add Essential Oil (Optional):

• If you desire a pleasant fragrance for your laundry detergent, add 15-20 drops of your preferred essential oil. Stir the mixture again to incorporate the scent.

### 4. Store in an Airtight Container:

• Transfer the detergent into an airtight container for storage. A glass or plastic container with a lid works well.

# Usage:

- Use approximately 2-3 tablespoons of the DIY laundry detergent per load, depending on the size of your laundry and the washing machine capacity.
- Store the detergent in a cool, dry place.

## Tips:

- If the detergent clumps, simply break it apart with a spoon or fork before use.
- Experiment with different essential oil combinations to find your favorite scent.
